

TRAINING PROGRAM

A three-tiered training program for civilian behavioral health providers interested in working with service members, veterans and their families.

REFERRAL REGISTRY

A public, online registry searchable by location, condition, insurance type, telehealth, and more for service members, veterans and their families.

EACH TRAINING BUILDS ON THE ONE BEFORE

Tier One Training (one day)

Service Member Perspective, Deployment Cycle, and Military Culture

Tier Two Training (two days)

Sleep Disturbances, Traumatic Brain Injury,
Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder, Military Families, Suicide, and Ethics

Tier Three Training (two days per topic)

Acceptance & Commitment Therapy, CBT- Insomnia, CBT- Suicide Prevention, Cognitive Processing Therapy, and Prolonged Exposure Therapy
